VINEYARD NOTES: 2012 was a perfect growing year in the Rattlesnake Hills AVA The Morrison Vineyard was planted in 1968 and is the oldest in the AVA. The old vines struggle to produce 2 tons to the acre. The grapes are extremely small and produce a wine with extravagant concentration of fruit flavors and tannins.
