



2014 Petit Verdot Rattlesnake Hills

VINEYARD NOTES: Normally Petit Verdot is a blending grape, but due to the excellent growing conditions in the Rattlesnake Hills, it makes a tasty unique varietal. 2014 was a very warm year which makes for rich wines.
