



**2014 CABERNET SAUVIGNON**

**VINEYARD NOTES:** 2014 was a very warm year which resulted in a big jammy Cab. This is a blend of our two Cabernet Sauvignon vineyards. The Château Puryear vineyard is noted for soft tannins and ripe flavors. The Morrison Vineyard is distinguished by bright fruit and rich tannins.
