



## 2016 Chardonnay Rattlesnake Hills

**VINEYARD NOTES:** This wine comes from Shirley's Vineyard which is right around the winery. East-west rows give this vineyard extra hang-time so the grapes get riper without getting extra sugar. 2016 was another warm year resulting in riper flavors.

**Serving Notes:** Serve at cellar temperature 55°.
